Gentlemen:

We request administrative approval to drill our proposed Mexico Federal "K" No. 1E Basin Dakota well at a location 1190 feet from the south line and 2020 feet from the west line of the "short" Section 8, T28N, R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico. An orthodox location would be 1190 feet from the south and 2120 feet from the west line.

This unorthodox location is required due to the topography. An unnamed wash runs directly through the orthodox drilling location and the wash is butted up next to a bluff.

All offset operators have been notified by certified mail of this application.

We have asked Mr. Al Kendrick of your Aztec office to forward a copy of the surveyor plat. Attached is a plat showing offset ownership.
