

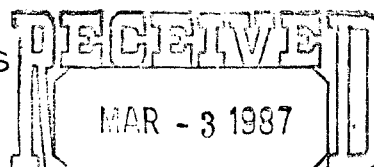

Our well is located 1,650 feet from the north section line; 130 feet from the east lease line; and 2,510 feet from the west lease line.

Driller's Zero 1 ft Above Rotary Table



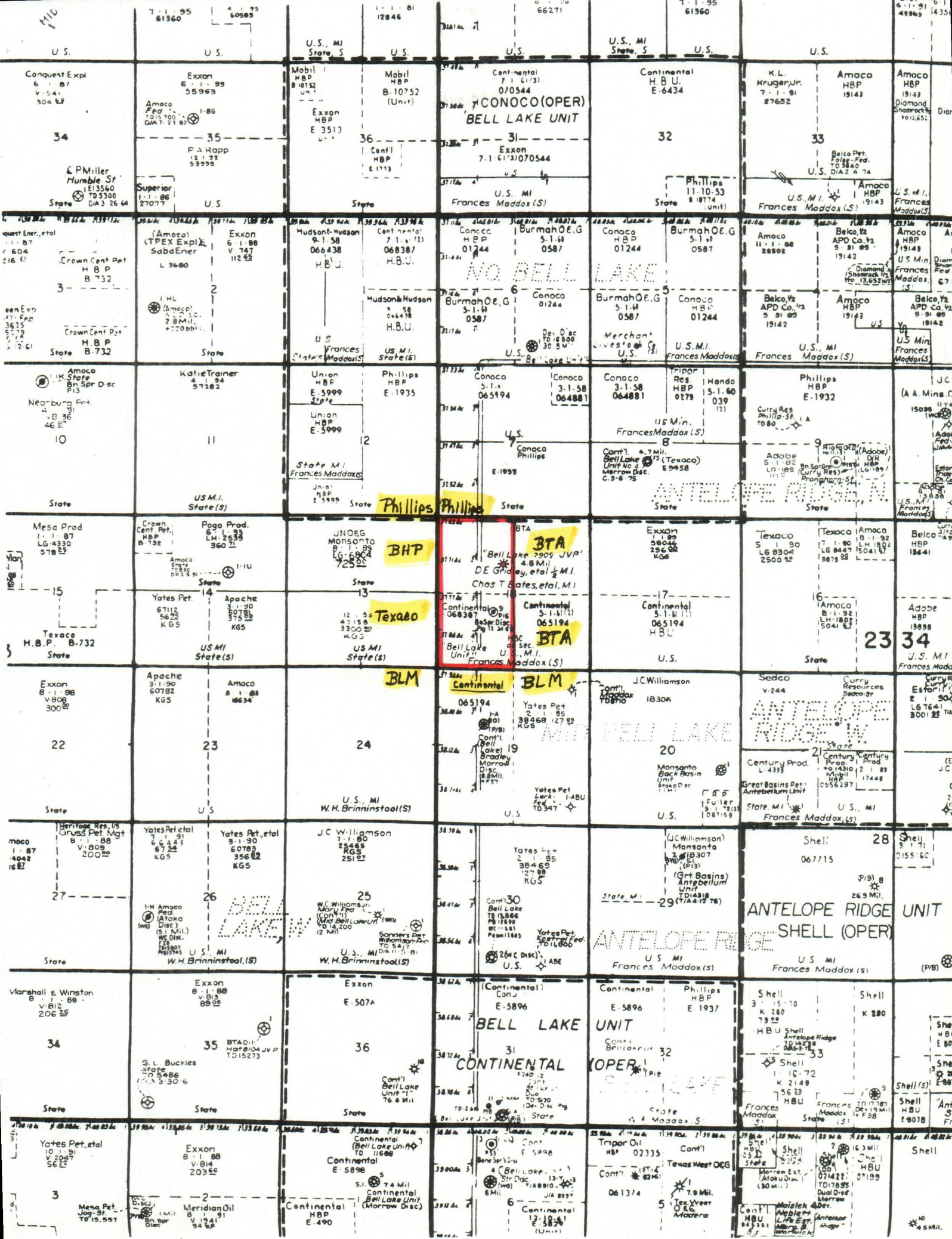
