Gentlemen:

Southland Royalty Company request administrative approval for an unorthodox location for the State 25 Comm. #1 located 1980' FSL and 2130' FWL of Section 25 T-19-S R-29-E Eddy County, New Mexico.

The well was originally drilled as a Morrow producer at a standard location. However, the Morrow interval was non-productive, and the well was subsequently plugged back and completed in the Strawn interval. This well falls within the pool limits of the Parkway Strawn pool and doesn't comply with the spacing requirement under Rule 4 of Commission Order No. R-4093. Southland, therefore, requests an unorthodox location as provided under Rule 5 for the recompletion of a well drilled to another horizon.

By a copy of this letter, we are notifying offset operators of our application for an unorthodox location.

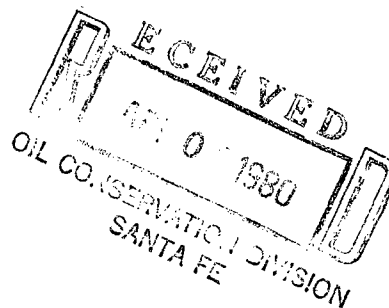
