COMMINGLING ORDER PC-1183

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle gas production from the Blanco-Mesaverde Prorated Gas (72319) Pool and Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas (71629) Pools from the following two diverse ownership wells located on Fee leases in San Juan County, New Mexico.

Stanolind Gas Com B Well No. 5 (API 30-045-32879)
Unit P, Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM
Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Lots 5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and Unit P (280.38 acre) Dedication


Stanolind Gas Com B Well No. 2 (API 30-045-32209)
Unit P, Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM
Blanco-Mesaverde Prorated Gas Pool, Lots 5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and Unit P (280.38 acre) Dedication

Each of these wells shall be equipped with a gas allocation meter that will continuously meter production prior to commingling. Gas production from each of the subject wells shall be determined by ratio utilizing allocation meter volumes and sales meter volumes. Oil production shall not be commingled.

This order may be amended in the future upon application by the operator, without notice to the owners of interests in the above-referenced wells, only to add wells located in these two spacing and proration units and producing from only these two Pools. Expansion beyond these two pools and/or beyond this 280.38 acre spacing unit shall require notice to all owners of gas within the proposed commingle.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority. The operator shall notify the Aztec district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
