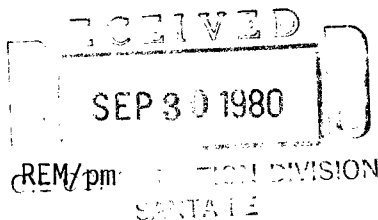

In response to your letter of September 18, 1980 regarding the non-standard location for subject well, this well was drilled 2080' FSL instead of 1980' FSL to avoid cutting a property line fence. This location was orthodox for the deeper formations originally applied for but subsequently, due to the completion in the shallower ABO zone and the reduction of the acreage assigned to the unit, it became a NSL.
