



At a hearing which occurred on March 26, 1980, Tenneco presented testimony to support our request for dual completion and downhole commingling for ten proposed wells located in Township 29 North, Range 10 West. As a result of that testimony the Commission granted approval as per Order No. R-6313.

Subsequent to the date of the above referenced hearing and prior to commencement of drilling, the surface owner requested that Tenneco move the original proposed location of the Marquis G. Eaton "A" #1E from Unit "A" to Unit "B", Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, due to the fact that the original location placed the well in an area of prime irrigated agricultural use. We relocated the well to accommodate the land owner and allow him maximum beneficial use of the surface. The Marquis G. Eaton "A" #1E has approved dual Chacra, Mesaverde/Dakota offsets that surround the proration unit.

Also, on the Bruce Sullivan Com "B" #1 the well was originally staked to be drilled in Unit "D", Section 25, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, and was submitted as such to the Commission for approval. However, it was later discovered that the proposed location was situated extremely close to an underground drainage system installed by the Bureau of Reclamation for flood control. We attempted to obtain an approval for an unorthodox location within Unit "D" but Amoco opposed the location. Our only other alternative was to move the location to 1990' FWL and 530' FNL which placed the well in Unit "C".

Considering the circumstances that necessitated the change of drillsites for the above referenced wells, it is Tenneco Oil Company's belief that the changes would not alter the testimony that was presented at the hearing and therefore respectfully requests that the Commission administratively amend Order No. R-6313 to include the above referenced wells drilled at the alternate locations.
