
Dear Mr. Williams:

This letter is in response to the request made by the Oil Conservation Commission to be notified when the Bureau of Land Management relocates an oil or gas well to an unorthodox location.

Amoso Production Company of Hobbs, New Mexico has recently staked a location for a gas well 660 FNL and 1980 FWL in Section 17, T. 23S., R. 24E. This location is situated on a slope of approximately 20 to 30 percent, and is also situated very close to a major drainage of the area. 


