

Hole in flow line at road crossing (buried) going to production equipment due to corrosion. Visually inspected the rest of the line. Replaced portion with polyethylene pipe. Shut pumping unit down and shut well in.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Area affected was a 60' by 30" strip down roadway. Replaced steel flow line with polyethylene pipe. Left area to aerate for a few days. Fertilized area with high nitrogen fertilizer. Back drag and treated affected area as needed
