Dear Mr. Black:

Reference is made to your application dated May 6, 1993 for a non-standard Mesaverde gas well location for your existing Childers Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1982 and completed in the Basin Dakota Pool at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location 1060 feet from the South line and 1275 feet from the East line (Unit M) of Section 3, Township 31 North Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico (Division Administrative Order NSL-1466).

It is my understanding that the Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, which pursuant to Rule 2(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is also unorthodox. Further, the S/2 of said Section 3 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Special Rules, the abovedescribed unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.

Further, Division Administrative Order NSL-1466 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
