Application is hereby made for administrative approval for an unorthodox location due to topography. This well is being located 200' to the west of the Moore Fed Com #2 which, due to parted casing, was completed in a shallower zone than the White City Penn as originally applied for. Note: The Moore Fed Com #2 was approved as an unorthodox location by NSL-1491 of April 12, 1982.


