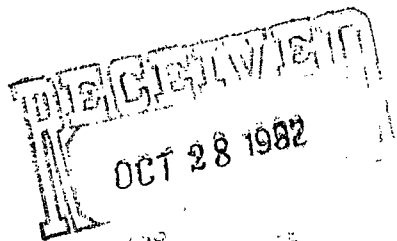

Application is hereby made for administrative approval for an unorthodox location due to topography. Exhibit I is an Area Topographic Plat, Exhibit II is a Form C102 outlining the 640 acre unit, Exhibit III is an Area Land Plat, and Exhibit IV is a plat of surrounding natural and cultural resources which are to be avoided.

This well is being proposed as an infill well for the 640 acre proration unit assigned to the Moore Fed Com #1. This well is being located 200' to the west of the Moore Fed Com #2 which, due to parted casing, was completed in a shallower zone than the White City Penn as originally applied for. Subject well will utilize part of the Moore Fed Com #2's existent pad and roads to minimize further disturbances in this area as outlined on Exhibit IV. Mesa Petroleum Co. engineers have requested moving the new location 200' to the west to insure avoidance of the existent well bore at the Moore Fed Com #2 location.

Offset operators are hereby notified of this request by copy of this letter sent via certified mail on this date.

Expeditious handling of this request is appreciated.

Note: The Moore Fed Com #2 was approved as an unorthodox location by NSL-1491 of April 12, 1982.

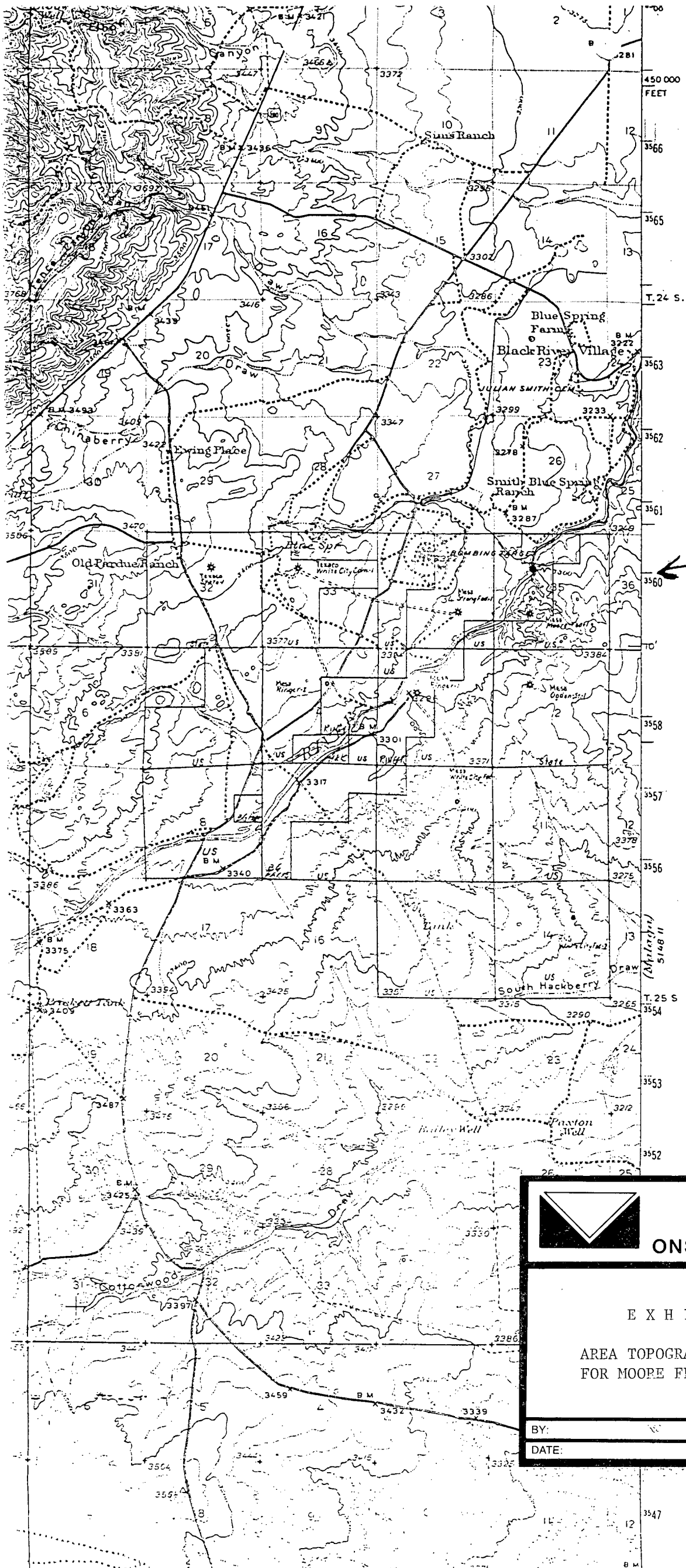

This location will facilitate the drilling of the subject well in the White City Penn Field.

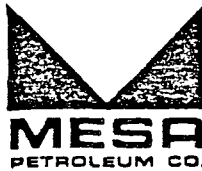

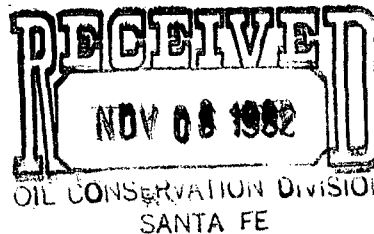

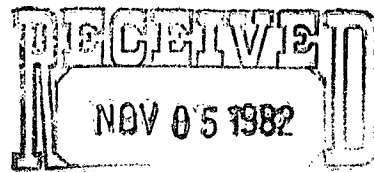
