

Sir:

This letter is a request for the approval of an unorthodox drilling location to be positioned, 1740' FWL, 1310' FNL, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T-29-N, R-14-W, San Juan County. Please refer to enclosed Plat, showing the adjoining operators and well numbers and locations. The proposed locations is indicated by an inked open circle and is outlined in red. (see attached Plat).

The necessity for this request is due to the heavily populated residential area in the Northern portion of the E $\frac{1}{2}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T-29-N, R-14-W, San Juan County, (refer to attached Plat). The current position of the San Juan River is indicated by two sets of dotted lines running NE-SW through the lower portion of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T-29-N, R-14-W, San Juan County, the position of the river rules out any possibility of situating the drill site within these confines. It is also not feasible to situate the drill site south of the river channel as all land south of the channel belongs to the Navajo Indian Tribe, and has been designated as reservation for said tribe (see attached Plat).

Also find enclosed a copy of form C-102 showing formation or pool name, the dedicated acreage and the footage location.


The off-setting operators have been notified by certified mail to the above request. The position of the off-setting operators to the well site have been indicated on the enclosed plat.

Showing the offset owners, it will be noted that the northern $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ is all residential area, which necessitates the request for the non-standard location, which is 1310' FNL 1740' FWL.

All distances must be from the corner boundaries of the Section.






