Reference is made to your application dated March 29, 1995, for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde infill gas well location in an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising the E/2 of Section 14, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, which currently has dedicated thereon the Warren "LS" Well No. 4 (API No. 30-045-07470), located at a standard gas well location 1700 feet from the North line and 1090 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 14.

It is our understanding that the subject well to be considered in this application, the Warren Com Well No. 2M (API No. 30-045-25567), located at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location 985 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 14 (approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-1608), is currently a producing gas well in the Basin-Dakota Pool and upon issuance of this order will be recompleted up-hole into the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of "General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described well located at an unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde gas well location is hereby approved.

All provisions of said Division Administrative Order NSP-1608 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
