Approximately 3,672 yd <sup>3</sup> of NGL impacted soil was removed from an excavation of approximately 6,500 ft <sup>2</sup> to a maximum depth of 21-feet bgs and transported to South Monument Landfarm for treatment. Upon receipt of laboratory analytical results indicating remedial thresholds had been achieved, site was backfilled with clean caliche and topsoil obtained from the landowner. Site remedial thresholds: TPH – 1,000 mg/Kg, benzene – 10 mg/Kg; BTEX – 50 mg/Kg
