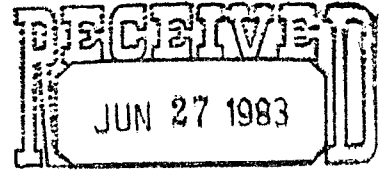

Gentlemen:

In the near future, we plan to file a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District I Office in Hobbs for permission to drill a new Jalmat gas well as a Section 103 infill well at an unorthodox location consisting of 330' FSL and 330' FEL Section 31, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject well will be drilled on an existing 160-acre non-standard Jalmat proration unit comprised of the SE/4 Section 31. At the present, the subject 160-acre tract contains two Jalmat (Gas) wells (M. F. Legal No. 1 in P-31-25-37 and M. F. Legal No. 2 in I-31-25-37) and our newly proposed M. F. Legal No. 5 will be simultaneously dedicated along with the two existing Jalmat producers to the SE/4 Section 31.

Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to drill the newly proposed M. F. Legal No. 5 at the unorthodox Jalmat location of 330' FSL and 330' FEL Section 31, and also for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the new infill well to the existing 160-acre non-standard Jalmat proration unit comprised of the SE/4 of Section 31, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The M. F. Legal No. 5 is being drilled at the proposed unorthodox location in order to minimize any interference with the numerous existing surface and subsurface obstructions situated on the tract. You will find enclosed a plat depicting the various topographic obstructions on the lease.

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Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer, and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy of 1978, an application will also be submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well.

A land plat showing the location of the two original Jalmat (Gas) wells on the 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed new infill well is also enclosed.

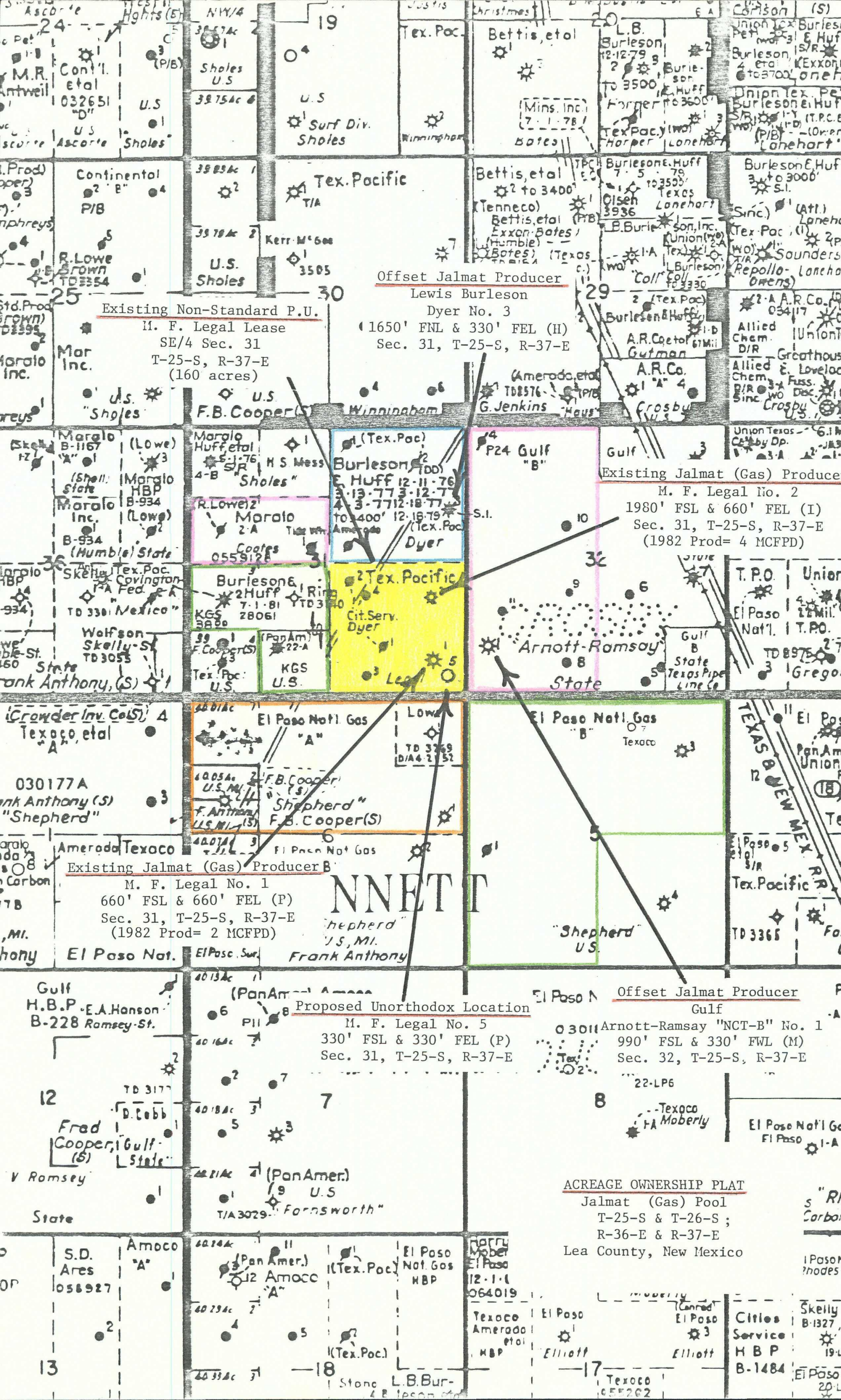
