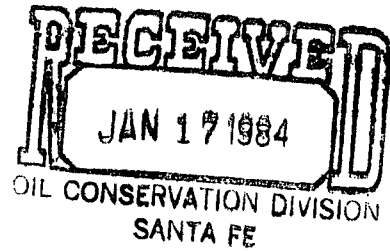

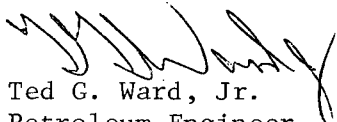
Dear Mr. Ramey:

We request an amendment to your Administrative Order NSL-1771 to permit us to move the location 50' from the original staking of our Northeast Caprock Queen Unit Well No. 35. The new location, 35Y, is 2565' from the West line and 1265' from the South line, Section 16, Township 12 South, Range 32 East, Caprock Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The original well was spudded and drilled to 1378', but the drilling contractor lost a bit and considered it more economically feasible to skid and start a new hole.

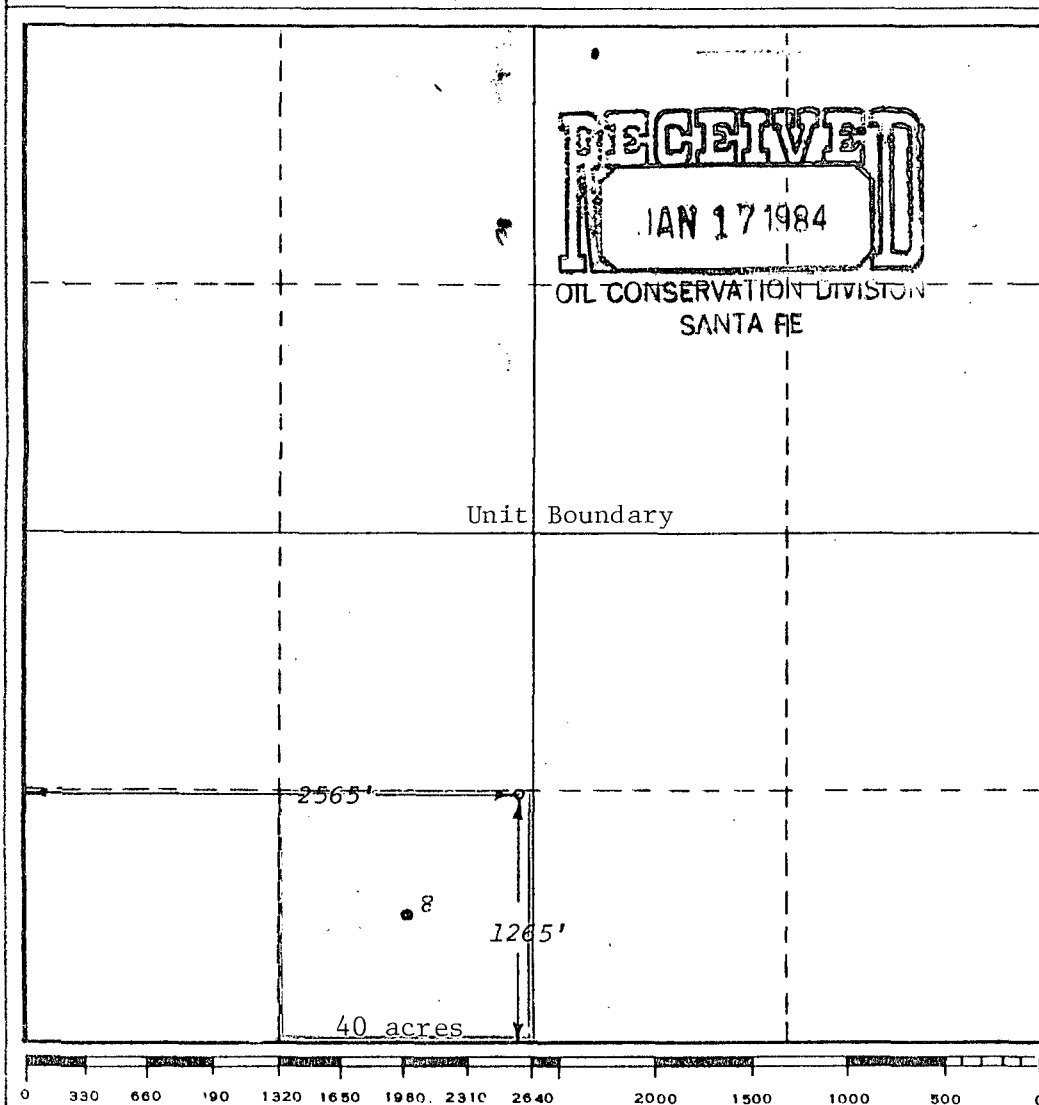

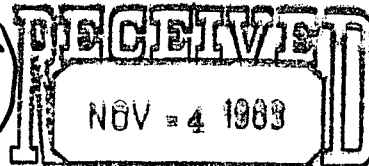

We would like to request an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104, Section C, for our proposed Northeast Caprock Queen Unit, Well No. 35, Caprock Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

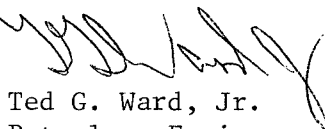
This well is being drilled to evaluate the effectiveness of the water flood project that has been conducted upon the property, and to determine the direction of future developments. At the present time, the property is near economic limit and additional development will be necessary to prolong the life of the property.

There is no offset production in the Queen reservoir surrounding this unit.

Plats are attached outlining the unit and indicating location of Well No. 35.

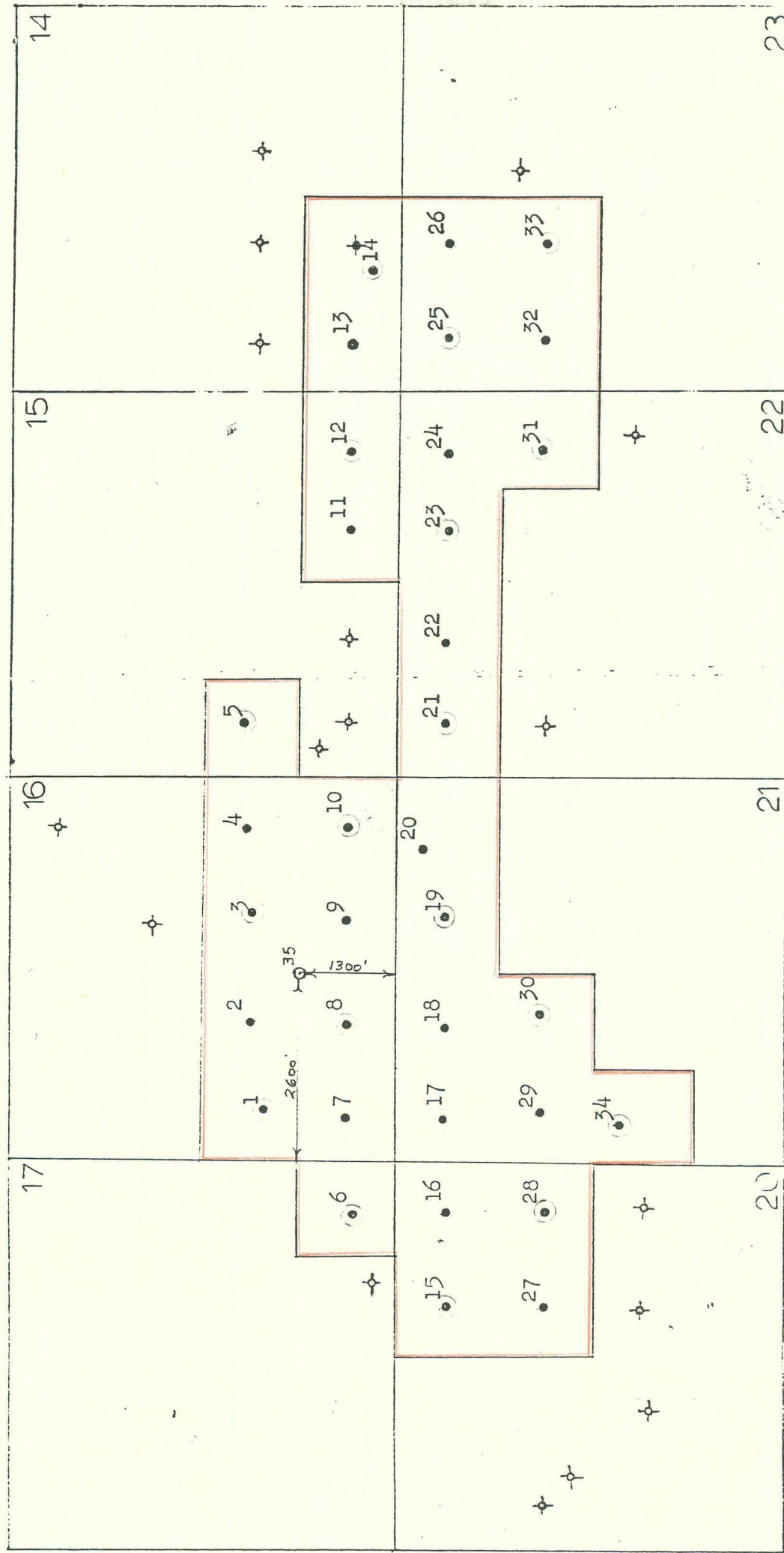
Administrative approval of this exception to Rule 104 is requested. Your assistance is appreciated.
