
Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location and simultaneous dedication for your Wells Federal Well No. 15 located 810 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line, NW/4 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3, Section 1 of Division Order No. R-1670, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved, and is to be simultaneously dedicated to the existing 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NW/4 of Section 5 with your Wells Federal Well No. 4 located in Unit F of said section, both wells in Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proration.
