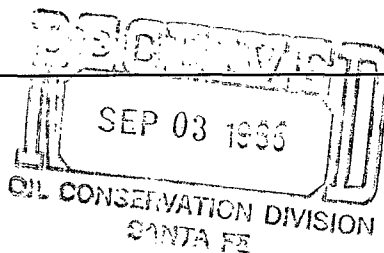

Applications for Permit to Drill will be applied for as soon as we receive approval. A plat of the Langlie-Jal Unit is attached reflecting both well locations.

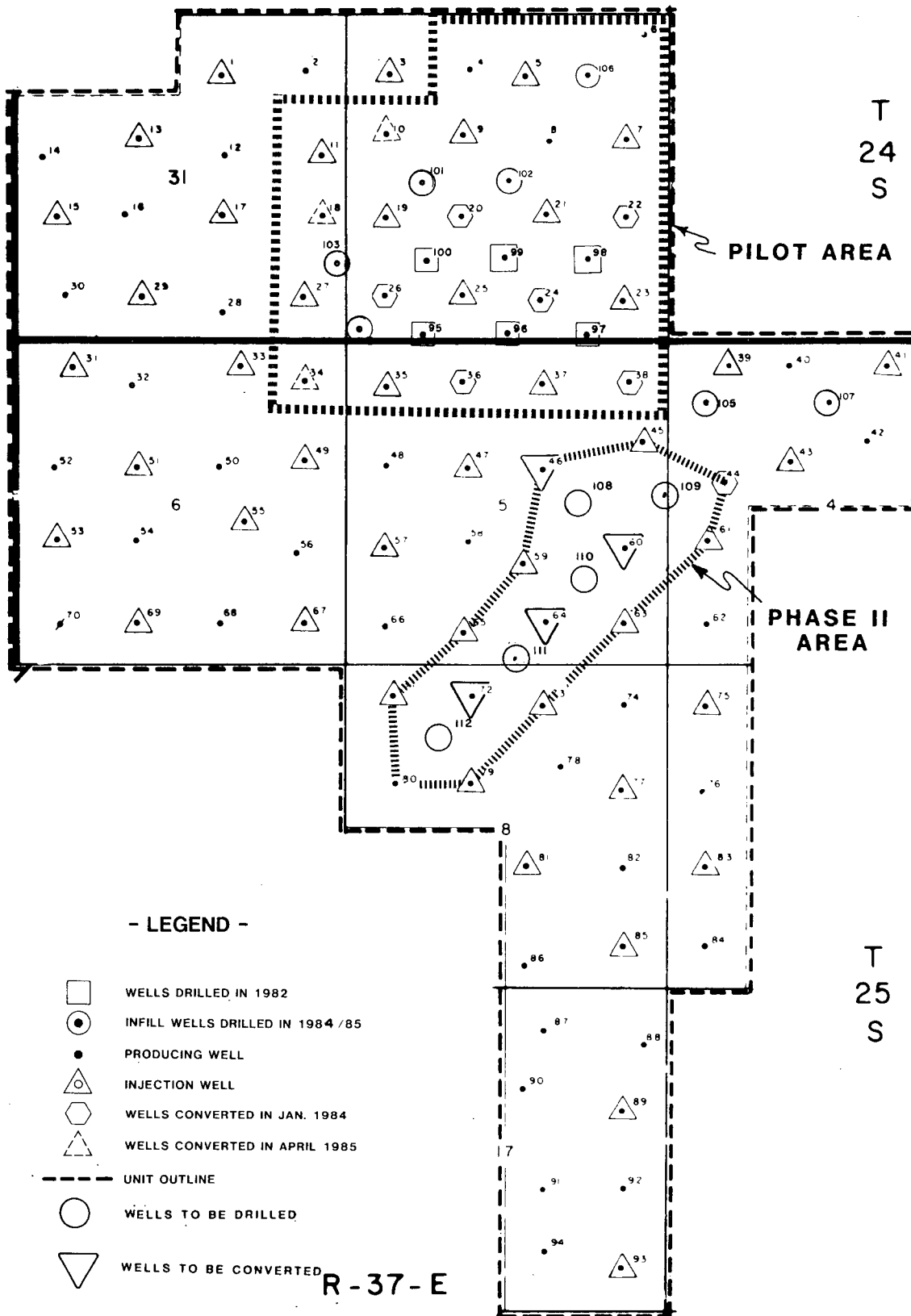
