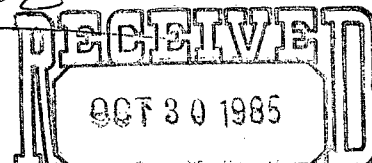

Gentlemen:

In the near future, we plan to file a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District I Office in Hobbs for permission to drill a new Jalmat (Gas) well as a Section 103 infill well at a non-standard location consisting of 660' FNL & 1820' FEL (B) of Section 22, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The H. S. Record No. 9 must necessarily be drilled at an unorthodox location because of previously drilled wells. H. S. Record No. 9 was moved 160' east of an orthodox location so as not to interfere with South Eunice Unit No. 6 which is operated by Conoco, Inc.

The subject well will be drilled on an existing 120-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit comprised of the NW/4 NE/4 & S/2 NE/4 Section 22, T-22-S, R-36-E. The subject 120-acre tract was originally dedicated to the H. S. Record No. 8, located 1980' FNL & 1400' FEL (G) Section 22, and was approved by Commission Order No. R-6927. However, the H. S. Record No. 8 is currently producing from the Jalmat (Oil) pool; therefore, the newly proposed H. S. Record No. 9 will be the only producing Jalmat (Gas) well on the proration unit.

We, therefore, request permission to drill the H. S. Record No. 9 as a Jalmat gas well at a non-standard proration unit. Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer, and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978, an application will be submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to obtain approval for the well as an infill well.

Remarks: You are hereby authorized to dedicate the above-described previously approved 120-acre non-standard Jalmat Gas spacing and proration unit (Division Order No. R-6927, dated March 26, 1982) to your H.S. Record Well No. 9; provided, however, that the H.S. Record Well No. 8, said unit's previously dedicated well, shall be shut-in and the Division be advised of same.

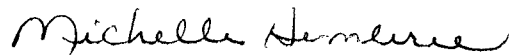

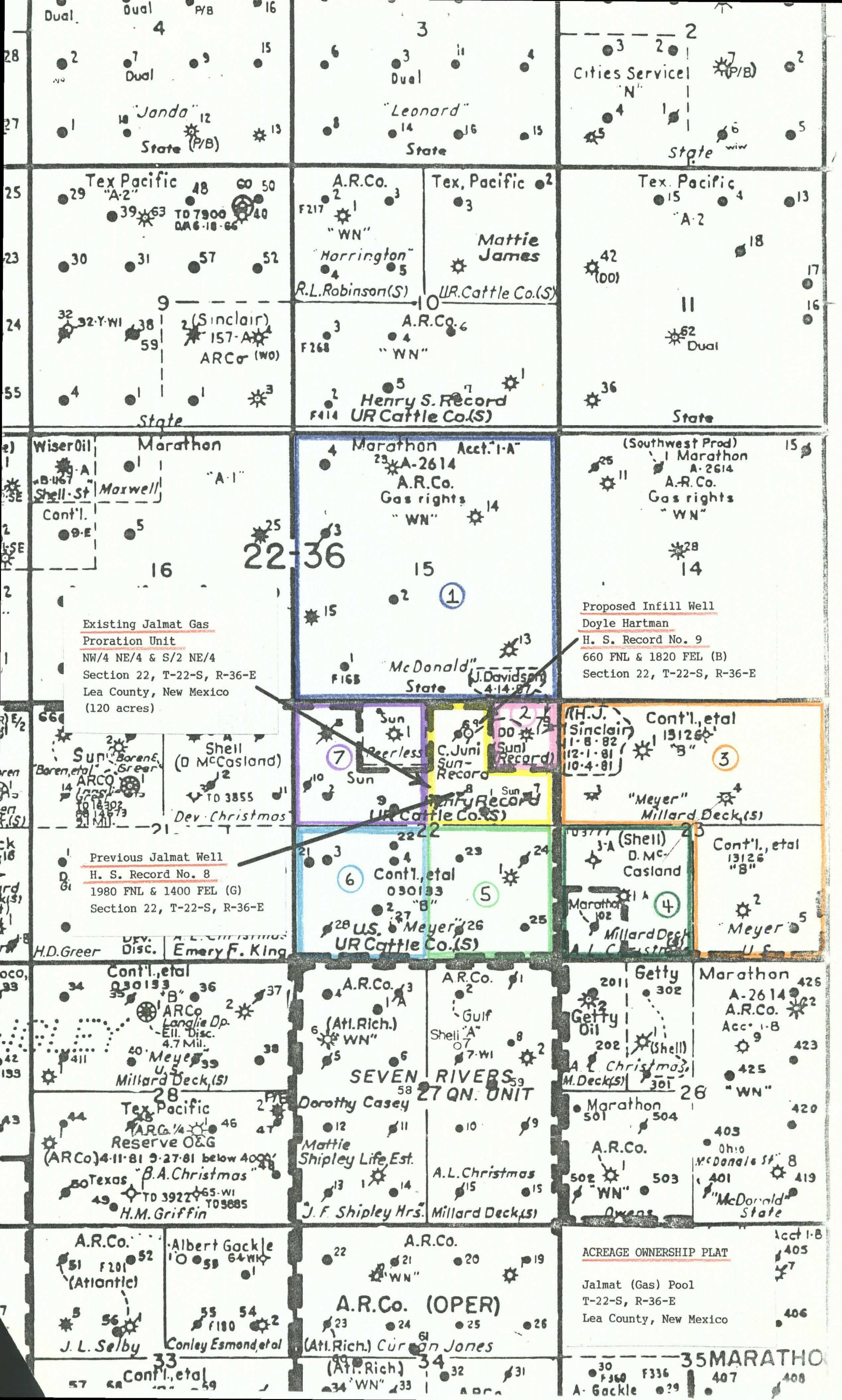
