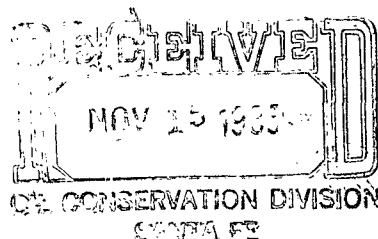

This is a revised request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco Mesa Verde Pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's Luthy "A" #4 at 2250' from the North line and 1610' from the East line of Section 1, T-26-N, R-8-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain in the form of very sheer cliffs makes it impossible to build an orthodox location in the northeast quarter of this section.

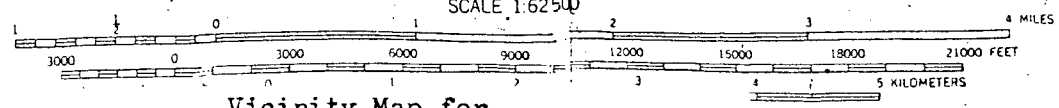

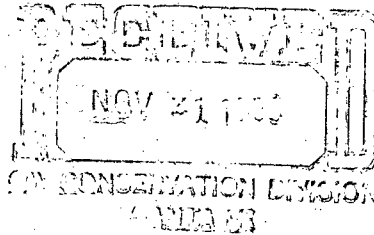
APPROXIMATE MEAN

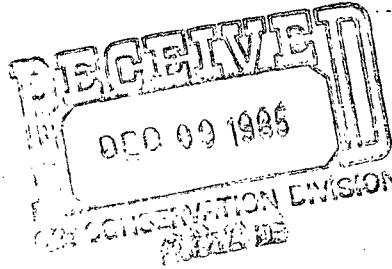
