

Dear Mr. Fesmire:

XTO Energy Inc. (XTO) requested administrative approval for an unorthodox location for the above referenced well as to the Dakota and Chacra formations in a letter dated July 19, 2007. After further review, XTO would like to amend the original application to include the Mancos formation. Attached for your reference are the following exhibits:

- 1. Well location plat (NMOCD Form C-102)
- 2. Topographic Map
- 3. Aerial Photograph
- 4. Dakota, Chacra, & Mancos formation Ownership Map
- 5. Dakota, Chacra, & Mancos formation Production Map

At the proposed location of 1,220' FSL and 2,525' FWL, the above captioned well is at a non-standard location to the east by 545' for the Dakota, Chacra, and Mancos formations. The well was placed at this location due to topographic issues and to obtain the greatest distance from the Kutz Federal No. 12 well (existing Dakota formation producing well located in the same quarter location). In addition, drilling this well as a directional well, in order to make the location standard, would not be economical for this area according to XTO's economics. The Dakota formation is spaced on a 320-acre W/2 stand-up unit and both the Chacra and Mancos formations are spaced on a 160-acre SW/4 unit.

In addition to XTO, the offsetting Dakota, Chacra, and Mancos operating rights to the east of the proposed location are owned by ConocoPhillips Company, who has been notified via Federal Express. In addition, all Dakota, Chacra, and Mancos operating rights owners in the W/2 of the section have been notified via either Federal Express or Express Mail.



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
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

Reference is made to the following:

- (a) XTO Energy, Inc.'s ("XTO" or "applicant") application for a non-standard well location (administrative application reference No. pCLP0720627605) for the Kutz Federal Well No. 12F that was submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 20, 2007; and
- (b) the Division's records pertinent to your request.

XTO requests approval of an unorthodox well location for its proposed Kutz Federal Well No. 12F in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool (Prorated Gas – 71599) and the Otero-Chacra Pool (Gas – 82329) to be drilled 1220 feet from the South line and 2525 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 21, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of Section 21 is to be dedicated to the well in the Otero-Chacra Pool forming a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit. The well is also to be dedicated to an existing 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 21.

The Otero-Chacra Pool is currently governed by Division Rule 19.15.3.104(C)(3) which requires standard 160-acre spacing and proration units with wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the unit nor closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary.

The Basin-Dakota Gas Pool is currently governed by special pool rules established by Division Order No. R-10987, as amended, which require standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration units with initial and infill wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the gas proration unit and no closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary.

The applicant presented evidence to demonstrate that the proposed unorthodox location is necessitated by topographic considerations within the SW/4 of Section 21, as well as engineering considerations, namely XTO's desire to maximize the distance between the proposed well and the XTO Kutz Federal Well No. 12, an existing Basin-Dakota Gas Pool producing well located within the SW/4 of Section 21.

The applicant provided notice of its application to the owners of operating rights within the E/2 of Section 21, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, being the affected offset acreage. The applicant also provided notice to the owners of operating rights within the Chacra and Dakota formations within the W/2 of Section 21. No party objected to the application within the 20-day waiting period prescribed by Division Rule 19.15.3.104(F).

Division records show that the Kutz Federal Well No. 12F will be the only producing well from the Otero-Chacra Pool within the SW/4 of Section 21, and the fourth well producing from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool within the W/2 of Section 21.

Pursuant to the authority granted under the provisions of Division Rule19.15.3.104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool and Otero-Chacra Pool is hereby approved.

I have before me your amendment, dated August 9, 2007, of the above application to include the Mancos formation.

The form C-102 attached to your letter indicates that this will be a directional well, with a stated bottom-hole location 1980 FSL and 1980 FWL, an orthodox location, though it does not indicate where the well will penetrate the Mancos. The permit previously granted for this well for the Dakota and Chacra formations by Order NSL-5678, and your August 9 letter, both suggest that you contemplate a vertical well at the stated unorthodox surface location, 1220 FSL and 2525 FWL.
