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

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

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

Re: Application of Texland Petroleum-Hobbs, LLC, for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its State HF Com #2, to be drilled to the Drinkard formation at a surface location 1897 feet from the South line and 957 feet from the East line of Sec. 33, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Fesmire:

Texland Petroleum-Hobbs, LLC ("Texland") hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 F (2)-(4), of an unorthodox well location in the Hobbs Pool for its State HF Com #2 located 1897 feet from the South line and 957 feet from the East line of Section 33 (Unit I), Township 18 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

This proposed location in the Drinkard formation is unorthodox because it is governed by the Special Rules and Regulations for the Hobbs-Drinkard Pool which provide for wells on 80-acre spacing units to be located within a 150' of center of the boundary of the spacing unit. The proposed unorthodox well location is approximately 297 feet from the center boundary of the proposed spacing unit. A standard standup 80-acre spacing unit and proration unit comprised of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 33 will be dedicated to the well.

The non-standard location is required due to surface obstructions. The attached **Exhibit A**, is an aerial view of the City of Hobbs showing the proposed location, the obstructions and the need to move the location approx 297' west of center.

Exhibit B is a plat that shows the subject area, the 80-acre proposed spacing unit comprised of the S/2 SE/4 of Section 33, the proposed unorthodox well location and the offsetting spacing unit.

Exhibit C is the C-102 filed for the well that shows the surveyed location of the well.

Exhibit D is a list of affected parties. As required by Rule 1210 (A) (2), a copy of this application (with attachments) has been sent to those listed on Exhibit D in accordance with Rule 1207 (A) (2) and they have been advised that if they have an objection to this application it must be filed in writing with the Division's Santa Fe office within twenty days from the date this notice was sent.

Also enclosed is a proposed administrative order prepared by Texland on behalf of the Division.

Reference is made to your application dated September 4, 2007 for an unorthodox well location for Texland Petroleum-Hobbs, LLC's State HF Com #2, to be drilled to the Drinkard formation in the Hobbs-Drinkard Gas Pool.
