
Dear Ms. Atwater:

Reference is made to your application of January 19, 1990 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-2488 by changing the location of your West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit Well No. 140 to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project to be properly located 2150 feet from the South line and 1425 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Dollarhide Queen Pool, West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 32.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.

Said Order NSL-2488, dated March 30, 1988, with the exception of the location of the WDQSU Well No. 140, shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
