Amended Administrative Order NSL-2573

Dear Mr. Wacker:

The subject Administrative Order NSL-2573, dated September 12, 1988, authorized your Britt "B" Well No. 28 to be drilled at a non-standard oil well location in the Cass (Pennsylvanian) Oil Pool 2280 feet from the South line and 2020 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, the E/2 SW/4 of said Section 15 to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for the Cass Pool.


Per your letter dated November 15, 1988, it is our understanding that Conoco, Inc., upon drilling this well has decided to dually complete in both the Cass Pool and the Undesignated Skaggs Abo Gas Pool, and further requests that the unorthodox location provisions of the original order be expanded to include the Abo formation.

Therefore, by authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), Administrative Order NSL-2573 is hereby amended authorizing the location of the Britt "B" Well No. 28 as unorthodox in the Undesignated Skaggs Abo Gas Pool. Said well to be dedicated to the SW/4 of said Section 28 forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

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Further, all other provisions of Administrative Order NSL-2573 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
