Dear Mr. Hazen:

Reference is made to your application of August 31, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Carracus Unit "25-B" Well No. 13 to be located 1010 feet from the South line and 580 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, to test the Fruitland formation, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(1), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
