Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

Reference is made to your application of October 21, 1988, on behalf of Fred Pool Drilling, Inc., for a non-standard gas well location for the Mustang Federal Well No. 1 to be located 747 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Pennsylvanian (which includes the Undesignated Haystack Cisco Gas Pool) and the Montoya formations, Chaves County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 33 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
