✓ *Amended Administrative Order NSL-2634*


Dear Mr. Clark:

Reference is made to your letters dated October 27, 1989, and November 22, 1989 to amend the proposed location of your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 424. It is our understanding that the drilling pad for the original well site location approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-2634, dated November 7, 1989 was found unacceptable and needs to be moved so that the drilling pad can be situated as to avoid a certain archeological site.

Therefore, said Order NSL-2634 is hereby amended and the approved coal gas well location for the Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 424 shall be <sup>2075</sup>2073 feet from the North line and 1330 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico

All other provisions of original Order NSL-2634 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
