

Reference is made to your application of March 29, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within a secondary recovery unit for your South Red Lake Grayburg Unit No. 48 to be located 240 feet from the South line and 1010 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Red Lake Queen Grayburg San Andres Pool, South Red Lake Grayburg Unit Waterflood Project (Division Order No. R-2882), Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 36.
