

Dear Mr. Clark:

Reference is made to your application of April 24, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Northeast Blanco Well Unit No. 465 to be located 1020 feet from the North line and 780 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 1 and 2, the S/2 NE/4, and the SE/4 of said Section 1 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 321.10-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
