Reference is made to your application of June 20, 1989 on behalf of Dakota Resources, Inc. for a non-standard oil well location for your Wakan Tanka Federal Well No. 3 located 1550 feet from the South line and 2310 West feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Caprock Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico. The NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
