Gentlemen:

Chevron U. S. A. respectfully requests your approval of our administrative application for an unorthodox gas well location of 1920' FNL & 660' FEL, Unit H, Sec. 34, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico for our W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 24. We are also requesting approval to simultaneously dedicate a 480-acre proration unit (N/2 and SE/4 Section 34, T21S, R36E) to our W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Wells No. 14 and 24.

Due to the result of an annual GOR test in October, 1976, we were requested to reclassify our W. A. Ramsay #24 from a Eumont Oil well to a Eumont Gas well. The well was shut-in as uneconomical to produce at that time. Now, on October 4, 1989, this well was plugged-back from the Eumont Oil zone and recompleted in the Eumont Gas zone.

On October 16, 1989, Chevron filed an acreage dedication plat, Form C-102, to dedicate 480-acres to this well and our W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 14. Since the Eumont Gas Special Pool rules call for a minimum distance of 990' from an end or side boundary to assign a 320-acre or greater proration unit to a well, our W. A. Ramsay #24 is in an unorthodox location. That location is 1920' FNL and 660' FEL, Sec. 34, T21S, R36E.

Based on plug back and re-completion from oil to gas, Chevron requests your consideration and approval of this unorthodox gas well location for our W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 24. Concurrently, Chevron also requests your approval to simultaneously dedicate the indicated 480-acre proration unit to the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Wells No. 14 and 24.

Chevron is providing offset operators a copy of this application by certified mail as their notification. Letters requesting "Waiver To Objection" have also been furnished each offset operator. If further information is required, please contact Mr. A. W. Bohling at (505) 393-4121.

By Division Administrative Order NSL-2721-A, dated August 17, 1990, a third well to be recompleted to the Eumont Gas Pool, the W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well No. 27, located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 34 was approved. Authorization was also given in said NSL-2721-A to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well Nos. 14, 24, and 27 to the subject GPU.

By Division Administrative Order NSL-2721-B(SD), dated April 1, 1991, a forth well to be recompleted to the Eumont Gas Pool, the W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well No. 28, located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 34 was approved. Authorization was also granted by said Order NSL-2721-B to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well Nos. 14, 24, 27 and 28.

It is our understanding that the subject well in this application is temporarily abandoned in the Lower Queen interval of the Gulf Ramsey Queen Waterflood Project however said well will be plugged back to the gas producing Upper Queen interval of the Eumont Gas Pool upon issuance of this order.



Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the GPU from all of the said wells in any proportion.

All provisions of Division Administrative Orders NSL-2721(SD), NSL-2721-A, and NSL-2721-B(SD) Division Order No. R-596 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
