Reference is made to your application of December 5, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington San Andres Unit Well No. 61 to be located 2545 feet from the North line and 100 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 6, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
