

Dear Mr. Maples:

Reference is made to your application of December 13, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Vacuum Abo Unit, Tract 6 Well No. 86 to be located 50 feet from the South line and 2480 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Vacuum Abo Reef Pool, Vacuum Abo Pressure Maintenance Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 33.
