Dear Mr. Bertoglio:

Reference is made to your application of December 14, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your existing E.H. Pipkin Well No. 8-E located 950 feet from the South line and 890 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 1, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, which is presently completed in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool. Lots 1 and 2, the S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 of said Section 1 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320.24-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
