

Dear Mr. Smith:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of Bill Fenn, Inc. of February 5, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location for your Buffalo Valley "34" Federal Com Well No. 1 to be located 1190 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Undesignated Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
