

Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application dated February 14, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Carracas Unit "25-B" Well No. 3 to be located 920 feet from the North line and 1850 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
