Amended Administrative Order NSL-2836

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated August 16, 1990 to amend the unorthodox location of your proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 306 (which was the subject of Division Administrative Order NSL-2836, dated July 30, 1990) from the previously approved location 985 feet from the South line and 1085 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 22, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to a new location being 965 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 22.


It is our understanding that the proposed change was necessitated due to operational considerations and various surface conditions in the Carson National Forest.

The applicant in this matter, Meridian Oil, Inc., assumed operatorship of the subject wellsite from Evergreen Operations Corporation and has made a proper filing to amend the subject location pursuant to Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulation for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768. The subject application is hereby approved and said Order NSL-2836 is hereby amended to reflect the well location as 965 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 22.
