Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated June 20, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Huerfano Unit Well No. 252 which was drilled in 1974 and completed as a gas well in the Angel Peak Gallup Associated Pool 1755 feet from the South line and 1050 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Gallup zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 1 and 2, the S/2 NE/4, and SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of said Section 1 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 319.87-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
