Dear Mr. Sanders:

Reference is made to your application dated September 29, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 30-5 Unit Well No. 210 to be located 1259 feet from the South line and 745 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Lots 1 through 4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 30 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 318.25-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
