Various companies have filed requests with your office for administrative approval of non-standard gas well locations in the San Juan Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool. We are opposed to drilling any well at the proposed locations without compensation to our company for taking of our gas.

We also noticed that each of the operators has clearly avoided furnishing the logs to us which will establish the drainage on our resources of coal and gas and therefore, we sincerely request that the proposed locations not be approved.

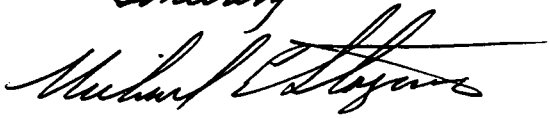
Dear Mr. Seymour

Per your letter dated November 9, 1990 concerning the BHP Petroleum (America) Inc. Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 390 located 245 feet from the South line and 1530 feet from the West line (Unit W) of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, N.M.P.M., Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, by Division Administrative Order NSL-2896 dated October 12, 1990 BHP was granted authorization to drill said well at the aforementioned unorthodox coal gas well location. It was found by the Division at that time that the applicant had filed a proper application pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768. No

objections were received within the prescribed 20-day waiting period, said Order was then issued (see attached copy).

If you are still in the opinion that said application was filed improperly or that General Minerals' rights are being violated, you may wish to file an application for hearing pursuant to General Rules 1201 through 1223.
