Gentlemen:

We, on behalf of Falcon Seaboard Gas Company, hereby make application for approval of the location of the subject well to be located 825' FNL 1835' FWL of Section 11, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The reasons for the non-standard location is due to topography. The topography is too severe in the southwest quarter for a location. The Forest Service objected to the drilling of a well on the south side of Vaqueros Canyon. An attempt was made to located the well on the south side of US-64, but an archaeological site was found there. Therefore, this is the only logical location in the west half of Section 11 to locate the well.

The attached exhibits show the situation at the location and surrounding area.

All offset operators and lease owners are being notified by certified mail at this mailing. The Return Receipt Cards will be provided when they are returned.

It is my belief that the information contained in this application is true and correct according to the information available to me.







Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool


