Dear Mr. Bruce:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of BHP Petroleum, Inc. dated October 5, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location to be drilled 660 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 24, Township 8 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Ordovician formation, Chaves County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104F(II) the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
