Dear Mr. Libersat:

Reference is made to your application dated January 16, 1991, for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Rosa Unit Well No. 83 which was drilled in 1981 and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 790 feet from the North line and 1730 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, the W/2 of said Section 15 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
