Attached is an administrative application for NMOCD approval of a Non-Standard Gas well location and Simultaneous Dedication in the Eumont YTS-7RVRS-QN (Pro Gas) Pool.

From this year's annual Gas-Oil-Ratio Test, the **W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) # 40** needs to be reclassified from an oil well to a gas well (see attached NMOCD letter notice dated April 29, 1996). The well is located 660' FNL and 660' FEL in Section 27 of T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Because the subject well is located less than 1650' from the boundary of a 640-acre GPU, we are requesting an NMOCD approval of a Non-Standard Gas well location. We are also requesting that the NMOCD approve a Simultaneous Dedication of this well with the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Nos. 17, 29, 35, 37, 42, and 46 which produce on an existing standard 640-acre Eumont gas spacing and proration unit (GPU). This GPU comprises all of Section 27 in T-21-S, R-36-E, by Division Order R-4496, Administrative Orders NSL-3000(SD), NSL-3000-A(SD), and NSL-3000-B(SD).

A copy of this administrative application is being provided to all required offset operators via Certified Mail. Attached is a commercial map and Form C-102 plats

which show the locations of the wells in the proration unit. Also included is a copy of the letter sent to offset operators.

Gentlemen:

The annual Gas-Oil-Ratio Test for the above referenced well indicated this well should be reclassified from an oil well to a gas well in the Eumont Pool, with the oil allowable being cancelled effective July 1, 1996.

If this test does not reflect the proper classification of this well, please submit a re-test by June 28, 1996.

If the well is to be reclassified from oil to gas you will need to submit the following:

- 1.) Form C-102 acreage dedication plat for the well, outlining a standard 640 acres proration unit or application for a NSP.
- 2.) Form C-104 showing reclassification from oil to gas effective July 1, 1996, indicating transporters of condensate and dry gas for this well.
- 3.) Indicate if gas well gas is separately metered.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 14, 1973, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>21st</u> day of March, 1973, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks authority to simultaneously dedicate a 640-acre standard gas proration unit, Eumont Gas Pool, to two wells, the W. A. Ramsay Well No. 17 at a standard location in Unit J, and W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 at a non-standard location in Unit E, Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks to produce the allowable from said gas proration unit from either or both of said wells in any proportion.

(4) That the applicant further seeks the approval of the non-standard location of said W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 27, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(5) That approval of the subject application for simultaneous dedication and non-standard location will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights. Case NO. 491/ Order No. R-4496

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate a 640-acre standard gas proration unit, Eumont Gas Pool, to two wells, the W. A. Ramsay Well No. 17 at a standard location in Unit J, and W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 at a non-standard location in Unit E, Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) That the allowable assigned to said proration unit plus the underage accrued from January through March, 1973, may be produced from either or both of said wells in any proportion.

(3) That the non-standard location of the applicant's W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 27 in said pool is hereby approved.

(4) That the effective date of this order shall be April 1, 1973.

(5) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
