Reference is made to your application dated June 24, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your G.J. West Co-op Unit Well No. 99 to be located 760 feet from the South line and 1420 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, G.J. West Co-op Unit Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 21.
