Dear Ms. Malik:

Reference is made to your application dated June 17, 1991, for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location in an existing non-standard 230.32-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising lots 9 through 14 of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-3327, dated October 11, 1967 and presently has dedicated thereon the Shell "E" State Com Well No. 1 located 3300 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit J) of said Section 6 and to the Shell "E" State Com Well No. 2 located 3566 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 6.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location in said Section 17 is hereby approved:




Dear Mr. Lemay:




Dear Ms. Malik:

Reference is made to your application dated July 23, 1991, requesting amendment to Division Administrative Order NSL-3030(SD), dated July 10, 1991, which authorized Meridian's Shell "E" State Com Well No. 3 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 3450 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the original well location was spotted on a map before surveying and said move is being requested because of the existence of a powerline and road at that location.

Division Administrative Order NSL-3030(SD) is hereby amended to show the well location for the Shell "E" State Com Well No. 3 to be "3500 feet from the North line and 690 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 6", all other provisions of said Order NSL-3030(SD) shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
