Reference is made to your applications dated August 6 and 16, 1991 on behalf of Collins & Ware, Inc. for a non-standard gas well location for the Fort "7" Well No. 1 to be drilled 534 feet from the North line and 1414 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Malaga Atoka Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
