Reference is made to your application dated September 3, 1991 for a non-standard carbon dioxide gas well location for your West Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit Well No. 22 to be located 990 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 13, Township 18 North, Range 29 East, NMPM, Tubb Formation, West Brave Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Area, Harding County, New Mexico. All of said Section 13 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 640-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said production.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Area, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-7737, the above described unorthodox carbon dioxide gas well location is hereby approved.
