Dear Mr. Linton:

Reference is made to your application dated November 26, 1991 for two non-standard oil well locations to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within the Twin Lakes - San Andres Waterflood Project, established by Division Order No. R-8611, and located within the Twin Lakes San Andres Unit Area, Twin Lakes San Andres Associated Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104F.(1), the following two unorthodox oil well locations are hereby approved.

- \* Twin Lakes San Andres Unit Well No. 121 to be located 1500 feet from the North line and 1405 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, said well to be dedicated to the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 5; and,
- \* Twin Lakes San Andres Unit Well No. 122 to be located 1400 feet from the North line and 250 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, said well to be dedicated to the SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 36.
