Reference is made to your application dated September 25, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient projection/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Artesia Metex Unit Well No. 63 to be located 1620 feet from the North line and 2500 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM Artesia Pool, Artesia Metex Unit Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico.
